



In June 2011 it became mandatory for Oregon Licensed Midwives to enter all birth statistics into the MANA (Midwives Alliance of North America) database.

Following are Andaluz statistics from June 2011 through December 2018.
We will continue to publish our statistics each spring to include the prior year.

Outcomes for clients in our care intrapartum (women who started labor in the care of Andaluz midwives) :	
Total vaginal births with clients who started labor with Andaluz midwives (birth center, home or hospital)	95.4%
Clients who had a cesarean birth	4.5%
Clients risked out in labor and transferred to the hospital	9.7%
Maternal transfer to hospital after birth of baby at birth center or home	3.2%
Baby transfer to hospital within 24hours after birth at birth center or home	0.9%
Intrauterine, intrapartum fetal demise (when a baby dies during labor, before birth) BEFORE admit to birth center	0.07%
Intrauterine, intrapartum fetal demise (when a baby dies during labor, before birth) AFTER admit to birth center	0%
Neonatal deaths, 1-7 days after birth	0.07%
Neonatal deaths, 8-28 days after birth	0%
VBACs (vaginal birth after cesarean) completed with Andaluz midwives	91.8%
Mothers who were still breastfeeding at last postpartum visit, typically 6wks after birth	98%
